Back in late January and early February 2018, there was a 10% correction in S&P 500 .SPX, with stock investors spooked as Treasury yield increases intensified with a monthly payrolls report showing the biggest wage gains for workers since 2009. This time around Oct 2018, strong economic data worried bond investors, who sent the US benchmark yield on Tuesday to 3.261 percent, the highest since early May 2011. These highlight one of the most dramatic market shifts in history — the slow but sure collapse in bond prices that has risen over the past three decades.
