China's yuan suffered its biggest monthly drop in June 2018, battered by worries that a deepening trade conflict with the United States will squeeze the economy and make investors takeout their money. Since then, the Chinese central bank has moved to more peaceful markets, pledging to keep the yuan at a stable and reasonable level. Yet many traders expect any bounce in the currency to be short-lived. A controlled decline in the yuan would help Beijing counter the impact on US tariffs. But with China's share of global exports close to 20 percent, a much bigger fall would have far-reaching consequences beyond its neighboring Asian shores, from Latin America to the heart of the Eurozone's biggest economy - Germany.

At the start of 2018, there was a 10% correction in the S&P 500 index, with investors spooked as Treasury yield increases intensified with monthly payrolls report showing the biggest wage gains for workers since 2009. Around Oct 2018, strong economic data worried bond investors, who sent the US benchmark yield to 3.261 percent on that faithful Tuesday, the highest since early May 2011. This highlights one of the most dramatic market shifts in history the slow but sure collapse in bond prices which have risen over the past three decades. The financial crisis supercharged the great bond bull rally by spurring global central banks' interest rate cuts across the world and the multitrillion-dollar bond-buying programs. The era of super-easy monetary policy is receding. 2018 marked the first year since the financial crisis where major central banks begun to shrink (or slow down their balance sheets). This reawakened concerns over the \$50tn global bond market where governments, companies, and banks raise crucial funding.
